**NOTIFICATION**

In pursuance to the Ministry of Shipping, Government of India, letter No.16(88)/2016-PD-VII dated 20 September 2016 and in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 48 and 50 of the Major Port Trusts Act, 1963, the Tariff Authority for Major Ports hereby notifies a provision for incorporation in its Scale of Rates of all the Major Port Trusts, to provide 80% discount for two years with effect from 20 September 2016, on the vessel related charges & cargo related charges for coastal transportation of vehicles through Ro-Ro ships, as in the Order appended hereto.

**ORDER**

(Passed on this 25th day of October 2016)

The Ministry of Shipping (MOS) vide its letter No. 16/(88)2016-PD-VII dated 20 September 2016 has conveyed its decision that, all the major ports will provide 80% discount with immediate effect for a period of two years, on the Vessel related charges & Cargo related charges for Coastal transportation of vehicles through Ro-Ro ships to promote the Coastal Ro-Ro ship service of Major Ports.

2. Accordingly, this Authority directs all the Major Port Trusts to incorporate the following provision in its Scale of Rates :-

“80% discount on vessels related charges and Cargo related charges for coastal transportation of vehicles through Ro-Ro ship will be granted for a period of two years will effect from 20 September 2016.”

3. All the Major Port Trusts are directed to amend their Scale of Rates accordingly.
