ORDER

(Passed on this 9th day of April 2012)

The 'Guidelines for Regulation of Tariff at Major Ports, 2004' were notified in the Gazette of India on 31 March 2005 vide Gazette No.39 by this Authority in compliance of policy directions issued by the Government of India under section 111 of the Major Port Trusts' Act, 1963. These guidelines came into effect from 31 March 2005 and as stipulated in clause 1.2 of the guidelines, will remain in force for a period of 5 years, i.e. up to 31 March 2010, unless reviewed earlier or extended by this Authority.

2. As advised by the Government of India in Ministry of Shipping this Authority extended the validity of the 'Guidelines for Regulation of Tariff at Major Ports, 2004' for a period of one year from 31 March 2010. Subsequently, the validity of the said Guidelines was further extended for a period of one year from 31 March 2011 or until further orders whichever is earlier vide Order No. TAMP/21/2009-WS dated 18 April 2011. This Order was published in the Gazette of India on 27 April 2011 vide Gazette 83.

3. The Government of India in Ministry of Shipping has now, vide its letter No.PR-14019/20/2009-PG dated 2 April 2012, advised this Authority to further extend the validity of the 'Guidelines for Regulation of Tariff at Major Ports, 2004' for a period of three months or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

4. Accordingly, the validity of the 'Guidelines for Regulation of Tariff at Major Ports, 2004' is further extended for a period of three months from 31 March 2012 or until further orders whichever is earlier.
