**Subject: Engagement of Intern to assist the Programmer in dealing with Information Technology related matters in TAMP- reg.**

Tariff Authority for Major Ports (TAMP) is a statutory Autonomous Body constituted under the provisions of the Major Port Trusts Act, 1963. The Authority is mandated to regulate the tariff of the Major Ports and the Private Terminals operating thereat.

2. This Authority is desirous to engage Intern on contract basis initially for one year which is extendable up to three years for assisting the Authority/ Officers of TAMP in discharging the duties relating to IT and to assist the Programmer in dealing with Information Technology matter. The remuneration and educational/ desirable qualification in brief expected for engagement of Intern is as below:-

- Essential / Desirable Educational qualification, experience and remuneration for Intern (on contract basis) is tabulated below:



Intern	B.Sc in Computer Science or equivalent.	i) BE/MCA or Equivalent ii) Diploma in Computer Hardware and Networking from a recognized Institute iii) Two years' experience in Computer Hardware, Software and Networking.

3. The General terms and conditions of engagement are as below:

- (i). The Intern will be engaged on contractual basis for not less than one year and not more than three years.
- (ii) The Intern will assist the Programmer in the discharge of his functions.

- (iii) The Intern may be paid a consolidated remuneration of ₹.22,500/- per month for B.Sc.in Computer Science or equivalent and ₹.30,000/-per month for BE/MCA and equivalent with 10% increase on completion of each year.
- (iv) The Intern may be allowed to avail 8 days casual leave in a calendar year. Apart from that the Intern may also be allowed to avail closed holidays, Saturdays and Sundays. No other benefit will be admissible.
- (v) The Intern should not have a conflict of interest and any breach thereof shall be viewed seriously.
- (vi) The Intern during the currency of the assignment or after conclusion of the work shall not disclose or make use in any manner any information / data, drawings, or any other material, whether written or oral collected in connection with the assignment without the prior written consent of the Authority. Furthermore, such material shall be the property of TAMP.
- (vii) The Intern on having accepted the offer of engagement will be asked to enter into a contract with TAMP which shall also have a confidentiality clause detailing the terms and conditions of engagement, before being assigned any work.
- (viii) Without prejudice and in addition to the legal remedies available to the Authority, the breach of contract executed by the Intern may be considered a sufficient ground for termination of the engagement made under contract and may further debar such Intern from future engagement by the Authority.
