**Case No. TAMP/43/2006-ABGKCTL**

**ORDER**

(Passed on this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of May 2011)

This case deals with the extension of the validity of the existing Scale of Rates (SOR) of the ABG Kandla Container Terminal Limited (ABGKCTL) for its operations at berths No.11 & 12 in Kandla Port Trust.

2. This Authority had approved the existing Scale of Rates of the ABGKCTL vide Order No.TAMP/43/2006-ABGKCTL dated 12 October 2007 with validity till 25 November 2010. At the request of the ABGKCTL, the validity of the existing SOR was subsequently extended till 31 March 2011 vide Order dated 29 November 2010.

3. The proposal filed by the ABGKCTL in December 2010 for revision of its Scale of Rates is registered as tariff case and is taken on consultation. The additional information / clarifications have been sought from the ABGKCTL and the KPT which are still awaited. Joint hearing in the case is setup on 5 May 2011.

4. Recognising the time required for examining the response before final disposal of the case after receipt of the requisite additional information/clarifications sought from the ABGKCTL and KPT, the validity of the existing SOR is extended from the date of its expiry till 30 September 2011 or till the effective date of implementation of the revised tariff, whichever is earlier.

5. If any surplus over and above the admissible cost and permissible return emerges for the period post 26 November 2010, during the review of its performance, such surplus will be set off fully in the tariff to be determined.
